




Bandlab instructions – Web Browser

1. Log on to www.bandlab.com and create a new account – this will ask you to create a username, password and enter an email address.

2. Once logged on, you will be taken to the home page.

From here you need to use the search bar at the top of the page which says 'Search Bandlab' and enter the words 'rainbow voices'. The search results should come up with the band Rainbow Voices with our logo – click on this.




3. On this page you will find all of the songs for Rainbow Voices. You can follow us by pressing request to join, which can be found where figure 1 is labelled on the diagram below.

To 'like' a track and be able to find it in your Library, press the heart in the same place as shown on figure 2.

To play the full track press the play button shown at figure 3.

To fork a song (to be able to mute/change volume of parts etc) press the green fork button, shown at figure 4. This will take you through to the Mix Editor (red button).



4. In the Mix Editor you will be able to see all audio lines in the song, shown by the coloured bars. The tracks are named in the box to the left hand side, and lyric cues are shown in the top of the coloured track lines.

Figure 1 shows the return to beginning button

Figure 2 shows the play/pause button

Figure 3 shows the skip to end button

Figure 4 shows the time bar, which will show the seconds as the song plays.

You can use the playback line shown at figure 5 (white triangle which you can drag) to move through the song. As this moves the time bar will change accordingly.

Figure 6 shows the mute (M) and solo (S) options for each track. Mute stops playing the voice selected, whereas solo plays only the track selected, muting out any other parts. To bring back everything, simply press the M or S again, dependent on what you have selected.

Figure 7 shows the volume slider for each track, this can be moved up or down to make each part louder or quieter.

Figure 8 shows the undo button, so that if you do accidentally move or record anything, it can be returned to the original.

Figure 9 is the exit button. When pressed it will ask you if you want to save your changes, select 'Don't Save' here.
